This document provides you with key information about this investment product. It is not marketing material. The information is required by law to help you understand the nature, risks, costs, potential gains and losses of this product and to help you compare it with other products.

What is this product?

Type

The product is in the form of a deposit provided under English law. It is not an interest bearing security. The payment obligations of the product manufacturer are not guaranteed by any entity.

Objectives

The product provides the potential for capital growth and does not pay interest. What you will receive at the end of the term of the product is not certain and will depend on the performance of the FTSE 100 Index (the **underlying asset**). The term of the product will end no later than October 2, 2028. However, the product may terminate early depending on the performance of the underlying asset. The product is not listed on an exchange.

Autocall feature: If the closing price of the underlying asset on any autocall observation date is at or above the autocall barrier, the product will terminate on the corresponding autocall payment date. In this case, you will receive the autocall payment multiplied by the deposit amount shown below for each deposit that you hold.

Repayment at maturity:

This section applies only if no autocall occurs as described above.

On October 2, 2028, you will receive the deposit amount.

The deposit amount is, at any time, the amount standing to the credit of your deposit account at such time, and excludes any amount already withdrawn or transferred.

The initial reference price of the underlying asset is the closing price on September 23, 2022.

The product terms also provide that if certain exceptional events occur (1) adjustments may be made to the product and/or (2) the product issuer may terminate the product early. These events are specified in the product terms and principally relate to the underlying asset, the product and the product manufacturer. The return (if any) you receive on such early termination is likely to be different from the scenarios described above.


Intended retail investor

The product is intended to be offered to retail investors who:

- 1. have the ability to make an informed investment decision through sufficient knowledge and understanding of the product and its specific risks and rewards, either independently or through professional advice, with experience of investing in and/or holding a number of similar products providing a similar market exposure;
- seek principal protection, subject to the issuer's ability to pay, expect the movement in the underlying asset to perform in a way that generates a favourable return, have an investment horizon of the recommended holding period specified below and understand that the product may terminate early;
- 3. accept the risk that the issuer could fail to pay or perform its obligations under the product but otherwise are not able to bear any loss of their investment;
- 4. are willing to accept a level of risk to achieve potential returns that is consistent with the summary risk indicator shown below.

What are the risks and what could I get in return?

Risk indicator





The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for 6 years. You cannot cash in early. You may have to pay significant extra costs to cash in early.

The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the product will lose money because of movements in the markets or because we are not able to pay you.

We have classified this product as 2 out of 7, which is a low risk class. This takes into account two elements: (1) the market risk - that the potential losses for future performance are rated at a low level; and (2) the credit risk - that poor market conditions are deemed very unlikely to impact our capacity to pay you.

You are entitled to receive back at least 100.00% of your capital. Any amount over this, and any additional return, depends on future market performance and is uncertain. However, this protection against future market performance will not apply if you cash in before October 2, 2028.

How long should I hold it and can I take money out early?

Recommended holding period: 6 years

You have the right to cancel your investment before September 23, 2022. The recommended holding period for the product is 6 years as the product is designed to be held until maturity; however the product may terminate early due to an autocall or an extraordinary event. You have no contractual right to terminate the product prior to maturity.
